

John Healey will speak on "Vatican II: What Happened to the Revolution?" on October 19 in the Parish Hall at Christ Church, 254 E. Putnam Avenue, Greenwich at 7:30 PM. The lecture is part of Voice of the Faithful's ongoing efforts to educate Catholics, and treat them as adults.

Dr. Healey will base his talk largely on Andrew Greeley's new book, "The Catholic Revolution: New Wine, Old Wineskins, and the Second Vatican Council."

Dr. John W. Healey served until recently as the founding director of the Archbishop Hughes Institute on Religion and Culture at Fordham University, where he was previously Dean of the School of General Studies and as Vice-President for Planning and Budget.

Dr. Healey received his B.A. and M.A. in philosophy from St. Louis University and his doctorate in theology (S.T.D.) from the Gregorian University (Rome) and also an M.B.A. from The Hagan School of Business at Iona College.

He retired from Fordham in August, 1999 but has continued to teach courses in the University's College at Sixty, and in Fordham College at Lincoln Center.

Jack has been active for a number of years in interreligious discussions. He served on the planning committee for the 1996 National Workshop on Jewish-Christian Relations and, more recently, for two interreligious conferences at Fordham on Religion and the Lawyer's Work. Both of the last two conferences were done in cooperation with Auburn Seminary and The Jewish Theological Seminary.

Included among Dr. Healey's recent articles are The American Catholic-Jewish Conversation: Where Is It Now?(culturefront); The Jewish-Christian Conversation As A Paradigm of Interreligious Dialogue ((jeevvdhara); Praying At Home, With Visitors (America); Buddhism and Christianity (Commonweal); Symbols Are Not Just Symbols (America) and From Diversity to Pluralism: The Roman Catholic Challenge and the Roman Catholic Opportunity, in Education as Transformation: Religious Pluralism, Spirituality, & A New Vision for Higher Education in America.

Dr. Healey lives in Bronxville, NY.
