## JAMES POST TO SPEAK AT VOICE OF THE FAITHFUL

James E. Post, President of Voice of the Faithful, will speak at the regular monthly meeting of Voice of the Faithful in the Diocese of Bridgeport on Thursday, November 6, at the First Congregational Church on the Green in Norwalk at 7:30 p.m.

One of the founders of VOTF at St. John the Evangelist Parish in Wellesley, Massachusetts, Dr. Post, professor at Boston University's School of Management, has traveled widely to spread the message of VOTF. He also participated in the conference "Being Catholic in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century: Crisis, Challenge, Opportunity" sponsored by VOTF in the Tri-State area (New York, New Jersey, Connecticut) on Saturday October 25 at the Bronx Campus of Fordham University. Some 1500 people attended the conference and went home educated, inspired, and energized to continue the work of reforming our Church.

Voice of the Faithful, an organization of mainstream Catholics, seeks "to provide a prayerful voice, attentive to the Spirit, through which the faithful can actively participate in the governance and guidance of the Catholic Church. Its goals are three: to support those who have been abused; to support priests of integrity, and to shape structural change within the Church.
